He found the perfect spot in Fairmont, N.C. What he needed was funding for the labor of love he envisioned. Woodall's goal; is to provide a comprehensive healing place for those who have sacrificed so much for our country. It would provide rehabilitation and relaxation, while getting them involved in various activities, learning new trades and connecting them with others to help them heal and to understand the difficulties of readjusting to civilian life.

Captain Woodall serves as the president and founder of the camp. His son, John T. Woodall, is the artistic director. As the more than 300-acre sanctuary grows, it will offer more opportunities for dedicated spaces and memorials all across the camp.
