Camp4Heroes, located in Fairmont, North Carolina, proudly presents HERO FEST, a Call To "Stand Tall" for our Heroes, at *Catch The Fire Event Center*, 2304 Page Rd., Durham, NC, on November 2, 2019. This Celebration of service, #standtall4herofestday will help fund the building of a wellness center at Camp4Heroes retreat for wounded veterans and first responders. Our veterans return home, not expecting a parade, but hoping for a chance to leave a dangerous environment and really feel that they will be able to enjoy the peace they fought to preserve. With the pride, love and loyalty they feel for their country and the people they fought to keep safe, they know there may be difficult days ahead, re-adjusting to coming home. Many will need help, especially those who come home wounded physically, emotionally or both.

Captain John Woodall (Woody) is a retired fire Captain from Raleigh N.C. He was the Chief of Operations with the North Carolina Fallen Firefighters Foundation from February 2000 until February 2011 and was the official liaison from North Carolina to New York after September 11, 2001. Woodall was looking for an answer to his dream of building a wellness center devoted to disabled veterans and first responders he called "heroes". He was determined to find a place where classes would be held, with room for a commercial kitchen, art studio, space for exercise and fitness training, and a library. He found the perfect spot in Fairmont, N.C. What he needed was funding for the labor of love he envisioned. Woodall's goal is to provide a comprehensive healing place for those who have sacrificed so much for our country. It would provide rehabilitation and relaxation, while getting them involved in various activities, learning new trades and connecting them with others to help them heal and to understand the difficulties of readjusting to civilian life.

Captain Woodall serves as the president and founder of Camp4Heroes, a 501(c)3 Non-Profit Organization. His son, John T. Woodall, is the artistic director. Camp4Heroes provides rehabilitation and relaxation for our "heroes," while getting them involved in various activities and learning new trades. Socialization helps them heal and better understand the difficulties of readjusting to civilian life. Woodall found an alternative way to heal heroes — by giving them purpose. Both father and son, have a passion for humanity and as musicians look at music as having the transformative power of art to heal body mind and spirit. In a collaboration with the Raleigh NC non-profit agency, Insightful Visionaries, the Camp4Heroes HERO FEST DAY #standtall4herofestday, has become a cause for engagement. Woodall intends to provide a good time for attendees, uplift for participants and by creating a broader awareness of the camp, encourage much needed funding. The day in "celebration of service" finale will be a Variety Show proudly showcasing the talents of veterans and first responders in the categories of music, dance, poetry, and comedy.
