New Polling Place Changes Slated for

November Municipal Elections

Tavares, FL- Alan Hays, Lake County Supervisor of Elections, announces polling place changes which will be in effect for the upcoming municipal elections scheduled for November 7, 2017. The following chart outlines the specific precincts and polling places which will be impacted by the change.
