As we engage the Lenten journey there are two calls to service, I would like you to consider as we partner together to be channels of God's extravagant healing love. Both of these arise from our **Disaster Response Ministry Network**: 1. **“Take the 2022 Challenge!”** and/or 2. **Send a Workgroup to Rebuild Houses in Dayton.**

The first opportunity I would like you or your congregation to consider is to “Take the 2022 Challenge”! Our goal is to assemble 2022 Church World Service Disaster

Response buckets and hygiene kits in 2022. Given the recent disasters that have swept through our country, notably in Kentucky, there is a great need for buckets and kits to help replace those that were used so that we can help both with current disasters and future needs.

Two important developments will help us in multiply our efforts you act before the end of March!

The national setting of the UCC through **Global HOPE** is offering **\$250.00**

matching grants to congregations who are putting kits and buckets together.

Also, once you have put your kits together, you don't have to store them. There is now a **Depot of Hope at Templed Hills** where your buckets and kits will be held until Church World Service comes to pick them up. Long Term Disaster Recovery In Dayton

In partnership with the Ohio Disciples Region, the Heartland Conference of the United Church of Christ Disaster Relief Network, UCC Disaster Ministries, and DOC Week of Compassion, **we are organizing volunteer teams of 4-10 people to finish interiors of new homes** for people rendered housing in secure following the tornado (and for some who were housing insecure even before the tornado).

Volunteers must be 14 years of age or older (mixed age groups must have 1 adult for every 4 volunteers under 18). **To register to volunteer**, and for more information about staying in the Dayton area
