What can I expect to see and do while on this pilgrimage?

During our six days together we will learn history of our southwestern US lands and the original residents there. We'll travel across the border into Mexico to witness communities in partnership with migrants and where borders are seen as places for encounter, compassion and the sharing of culture. We will visit an Audubon Center of native species of plants and animals, and we will walk with desert "Samaritans" who aid peoples from around the world who traverse there. We will hear speakers, watch films, attend workshops at an annual event called, "Commonground on the Border". We will attend a festival of singing and dancing and art-making. Each day we will sing, reflect, eat great food, and explore what we are called to contribute back home, as we find joy and celebration in the midst of confronting the humanitarian tragedies of immigration. We will worship at Southside Presbyterian Church in Tucson, the founding church of the "Sanctuary Movement" just prior to boarding our flights back home where you will discover that you are the same person, but different.
