Rev. Dr. Imani Jones is an ordained minister in the United Church of Christ. A native of Cleveland, Ohio, Rev. Jones is a graduate of The Ohio State University and Princeton Theological Seminary with Bachelor of Arts, Master of Divinity and Master of Theology degrees, and has a Doctor of Ministry degree from Ecumenical Theological Seminary. Currently, Rev. Jones is the Director of the Chaplaincy Department at The Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center, in Columbus, Ohio. Rev. Jones has a particular focus on the integration of African American voices in Clinical Pastoral Education curriculum development. She is a Board Certified Chaplain within the Association of Professional Chaplains and a Certified Educator in the Association for Clinical Pastoral Education. Rev. Jones, along with her husband, Colin, pastor at Advent U.C.C. in Columbus, Ohio.
