Role: Administrative Volunteer

Role Description:

The Administrative Volunteer will assist with various office administrative duties. These may include filing, stuffing envelopes, photo copying, scanning, front desk coverage, sanitation of foyer area and other tasks as required.

Requirements:

The Administrative Volunteer will possess basic computer/office skills, be willing to take direction and ask questions, and is reliable, flexible and organized.

Screening Process:

Volunteers will complete an application, interview, police security clearance, and 2 references.

Training:

Volunteers will receive an orientation to Catholic Family Service and on-the-job training as needed.

Commitment:

To be determined based upon needs of the organization and availability of the volunteer.

Time & Place:

Minimum 3 hours on Monday's (additional flexible time frames possible), working at the Central Office location: 250, 707 – 10th Ave SW

Supervision:

Volunteers will receive on-site supervision from administrative staff and check-in's via phone/email as needed.

Benefits:

The opportunity to gain valuable & practical administrative experience and to build a resume. Volunteers will have the opportunity to be a part of the team at Catholic Family Service and to further the purpose and ambitions of the organization.
