Have your CNG Cylinders been Properly Inspected?

The Federal Department of Transportation Standard No. 304 requires a label on each CNG cylinder stating that CNG cylinders should be visually inspected to ensure safety every 36 months or 36,000 miles and after a motor vehicle accident or fire.
