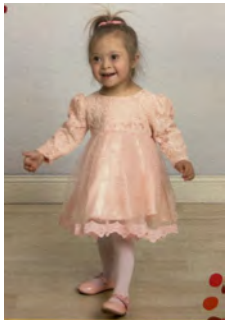

How Blessed Are We?



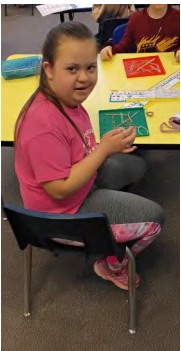
For many years Children's Outreach Ministries have been serving and ministering to children with special needs and their families. We would like to share the story of one of these children with you. Evonna Brinton came to us as a two-year-old with Down's Syndrome, she was not walking and had a feeding tube. Her parents were reluctant to enroll Evonna in Preschool, but after talking with Sharon Godfrey our Preschool Director, and hearing of her experience with special needs children their concerns were alleviated and Evonna started with us in 2016. She was a very energetic two-year-old who scooted on her bottom faster than most children could walk and kept us on our toes chasing after her. The Staff welcomed Evonna with open arms, and were willing to learn everything they needed to care for her and help her grow. Because of Evonna's developmental delays she was in our Preschool Program for four years.

At six years old her parents decided to homeschool her and supplement that with enrolling her in the Primary Program.



Primary Program was in its fourth year at the time, a program started by Pastor Misty Wintch and Sharon Godfrey. Its goal was to teach children who perhaps weren't ready for kindergarten or were very advanced and whose parents wanted them to have the special one on one teaching and attention that only a smaller program could provide. When Evonna started Primary, she was developmentally behind in her academics for a child her age. With the help of Sharon and the aides Evonna now knows all her letters and sounds, colors, shapes, and has progressed socially as well. She fits in with the children playing, interacting and communicating with them. In the beginning of every school year Sharon speaks with the children about differences in others, the fact that some people's brains work a little differently and some people's speech is not quite developed. She wanted to help the children learn how to interact with Evonna. The interesting part is the children had no idea it was Evonna she was talking about. We think that's awesome!

In the Spring of 2022 Evonna had a stroke, which affected the left side of her body leaving her with difficulty walking, talking and being able to use her hand. Unfortunately, because of the extent of the stroke Evonna was not able to finish out that school year. Because of how her classmates and teachers loved her cards, videos and pictures were constantly sent to Evonna to encourage and lift her up. It was a strong lesson for the children that year in love and the power of prayer. In Evonna's recovery God performed miracle after miracle in her life. When Evonna returned the next school year she had to be taught how to write with her right hand, and had lost some of her mobility, academics, and language. Sharon and the staff worked diligently with her to help relearn basic skills, and did therapy with her so that she could get back what she had lost. She has not only regained these skills but gone farther than where she was before the stroke happened. This is Evonna's last year in Primary and she will be greatly missed.



Not only has Evonna been part of our Preschool and Primary program, but she has also attended Summer CLASP for the past two years. She fits in perfectly and is well accepted by the other children. The children welcome her, play with her and love her. We look forward to her continuing in this ministry. It is amazing to see the changes, accomplishments and miracles that God has performed and granted in her life. We thank God that He allowed us the privilege of being part of it. Her parents always felt that we were a blessing to them, but it was Evonna who was the blessing to us.

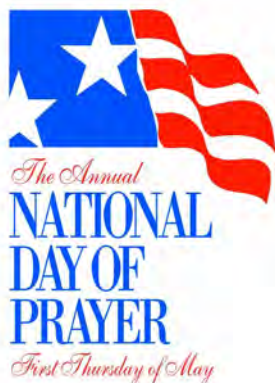

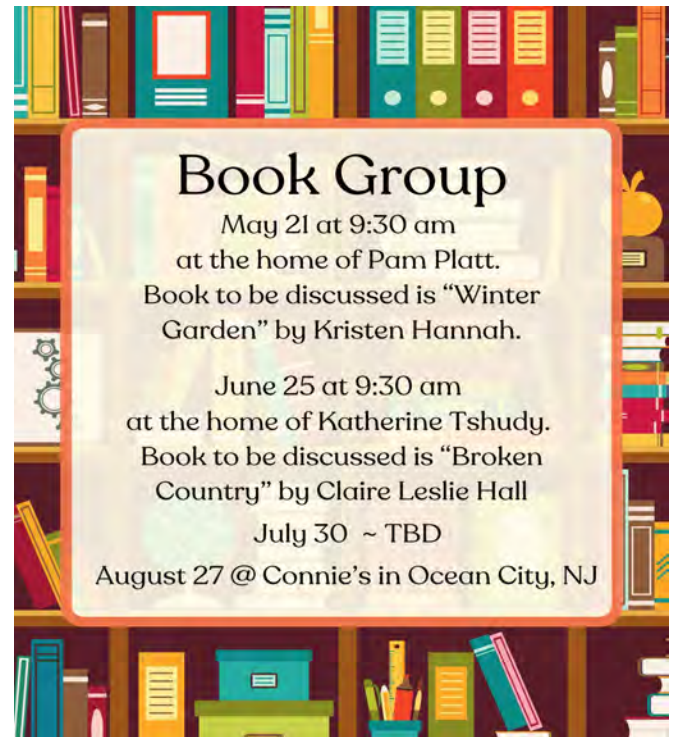
