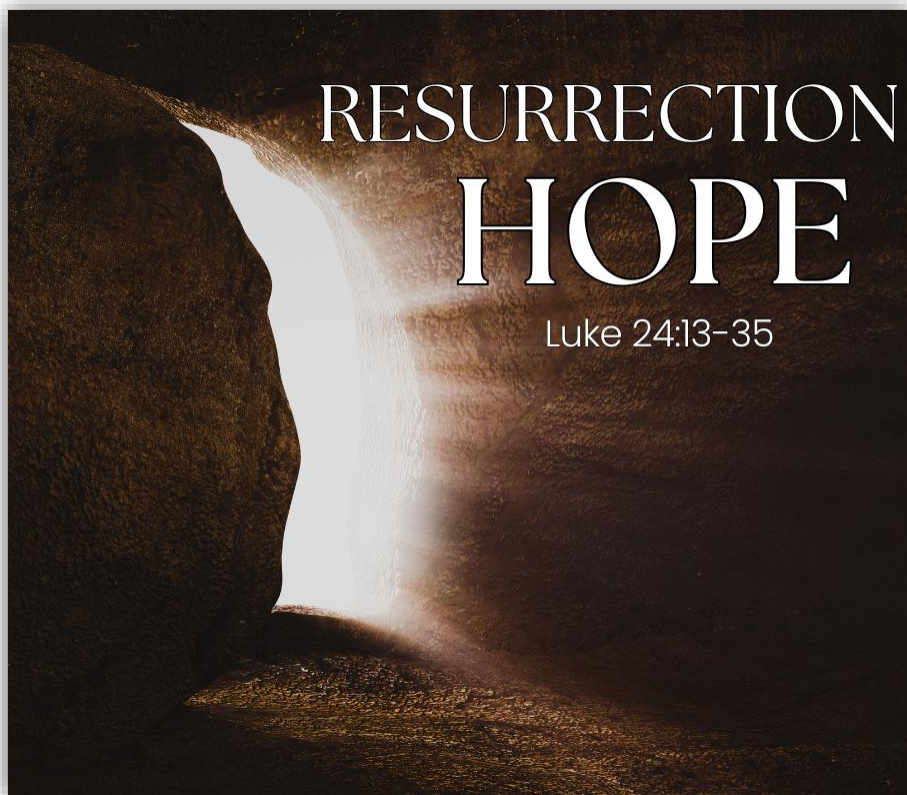

2025 April Church Board Highlights

- Thirty-three of thirty-five members were present.
- Senior Essay information has been distributed to high school seniors to be submitted by May 12th.
- Clarification from the Stewards Commission that while Board approval was given to transfer money from the Strategic Vision Funds to the General Fund due to a shortfall in giving at the beginning of the year, no funds have been transferred at this time.
- Will continue to brainstorm creative ideas on promoting stewardship.
- Thank you to all who participated in the Spring lawn clean-up on April 12th. While the weather was not as nice as hoped, lots of tasks were completed.
- The Witness Commission will be working with a member of the congregation who has volunteered to formulate a plan for a Welcoming New Families ministry.
- Love Feast will be held Thursday, April 17, 2025
- A Door Security Policy was approved with a committee formed to work out the logistics.
- On the recommendation of the Gifts Discernment Committee, the Board approved the following individuals to be confirmed at the Spring Congregational Meeting. They will be filling the following terms of office that have been vacated on the board due to resignations: Amber Criswell (COMB), Doreen Creighton (Moderator)
- Approval was given to Women's Ministries to open their own bank account, which will be funded entirely by their ministries.

A BIG THANK YOU for anyone that helped pack food or gave money to Feed My Starving Children at Willow Street. A few facts:

- Goal: Pack 400,000 meals. **Packed** 412,128
(Will feed 1,129 children one meal a day for one year)
- Goal: 2000 volunteer workers. Actual: 1,678
- Goal: \$118,000 to cover the cost of meals. Actual: \$94,000

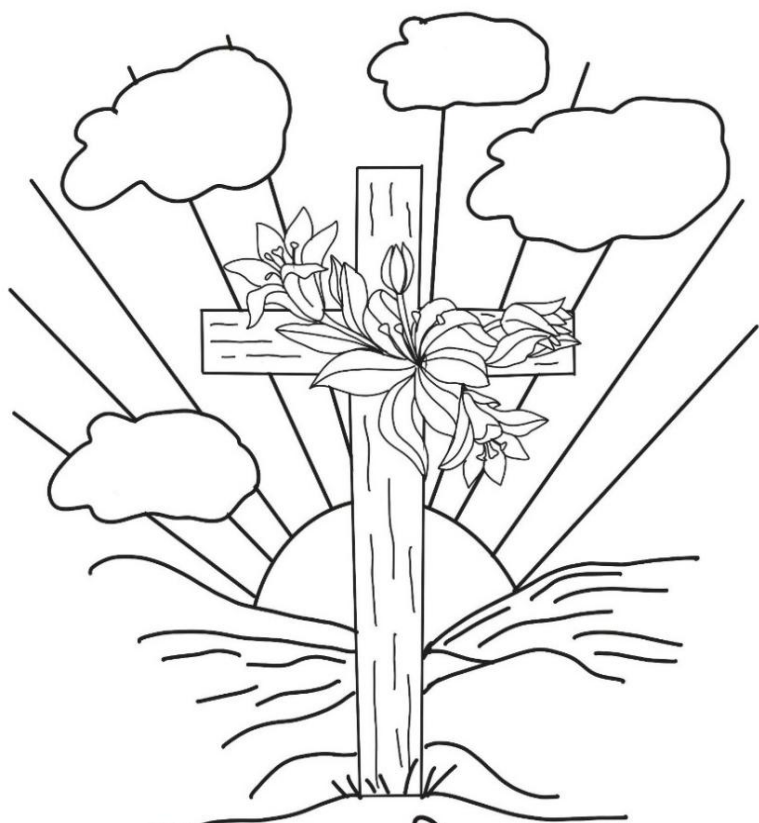
