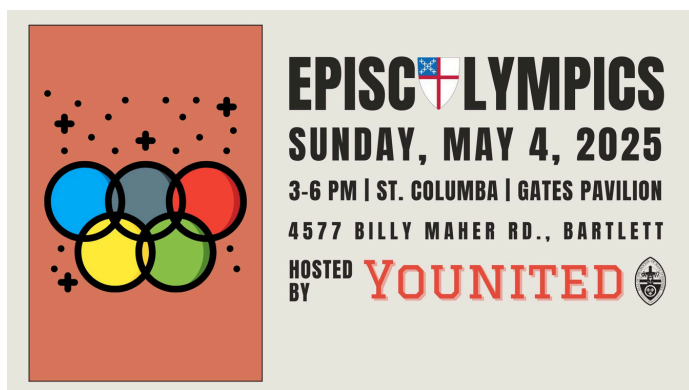


EPYC Dinner and Devotion
