Clearwater Ferry is teaming up with the City of Clearwater to alleviate Spring Break traffic getting to Clearwater Beach.

With the added capacity subsidized by the City of Clearwater, Clearwater Ferry will be able to offer increased frequency at key times on key dates during Spring.

For the first time ever in the Spring, Clearwater Ferry is also allowing passengers to make reservations to guarantee their seats on all their lines, effective immediately. There will be additional capacity available on all vessels and all departures for those who decide to walk up. The schedule of available reservations for March and April is already bookable on ClearwaterFerry.com.

Accommodations have also been made to enhance the comfort of the Downtown Clearwater Ferry waiting area during Spring, including tents for shade.

Although the Harborview Center and its adjacent lot are now closed to prepare for demolition, parking for Clearwater Ferry guests is still plentiful and free by the Downtown Clearwater landing. Clearwater Ferry recommends using lot 5 (behind the Main Library – 261 spaces) and lot 15 (access from Pierce Street – 63 spaces) as well as street parking on Drew Street when available. A full parking map is available on ClearwaterFerry.com.

Please note that the transportation agency will stop accepting cash payments on board its vessels starting March 1st, 2019, in an effort to protect its staff who are responsible for high amounts of monies on board. All vessels will continue to accept Credit Card/Debit Card payments on board, but all guests are encouraged to make reservations online to expedite the checkout process and guarantee their seats.

Guests will be happy to learn that Clearwater Ferry also updated its reservation system for a new platform that is much more user friendly.

Prices for rides remain as follows:

PURPLE LINE (each way) — Adults: \$4, Seniors/Military: \$3, Children: \$2, Under 3: FREE.
BLUE LINE (each way) — Adults: \$8, Seniors/Military: \$6, Dunedin Residents: \$5, Children: \$4, Under 3: FREE.

Guests are still encouraged to tip the crew with cash on board as a token of their satisfaction.
