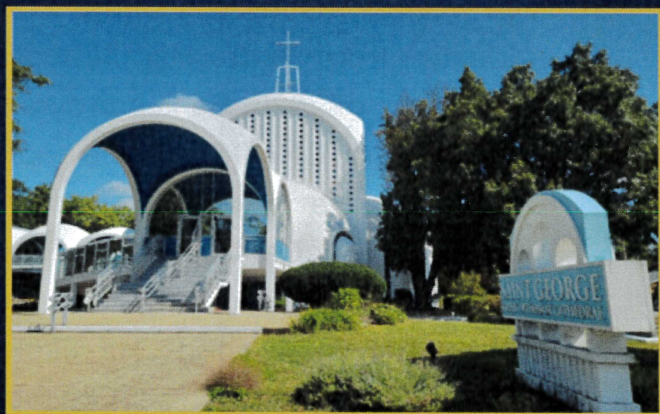




2026 High School Graduates
