

## Yearbook FAQ's

**Do I really need one?** Well no, but more often than not we have grown-ups asking to purchase one after yearbooks are distributed because now their kiddo would like one. Here are some ways kids use their yearbooks:

1. To see who is in their class after getting the class list.
2. Find their new teacher's picture.
3. Show their grown-up all the kids in their class (it's like a fun game of hide and seek to search through and find them!)

5. Or it is as simple as loving to see pictures of themselves, their friends or other staff they know!

Of course it is up to you but these are some things to consider!

**Can I purchase one after April 1st?** While we do order a few "extra" yearbooks, there really are only A FEW. The waitlist after April 1st becomes surprisingly long so it is not a guarantee you will receive one.

**Will my student be in the yearbook?** While it is no guarantee, our yearbook committee and photographers do their best to make sure that all kids are featured in the yearbook more than their school photo and class picture.

**Are the JJ and Robinson yearbooks different?** YES! Even the cover! There are two committees that take this project on, one for each school and they have full creative liberty to design it cover to cover. You will only see photos from the school yearbook you purchase!

**Will my students retake be in the yearbook?** Yes! All retakes will be used unless we are asked to use the students original. This includes class photos as well. Retakes will be used unless the teacher asks us to use the original.

**I have a 5<sup>th</sup> grader who wants their name on the book, do I purchase a yearbook in order to do that?** You do not! You just complete the separate form and send in \$5 to school and we will take care of the rest!
