Subject: Temporary Suspension of the DoW Trusted Traveler Program (TTP)

1. As of March 2, 2026, the Department of War (DoW) has suspended the Trusted Traveler Program (TTP) at military installations nationwide. This directive, issued by U.S. Northern Command (USNORTHCOM), implements heightened security measures across all entry gates due to escalating global conflicts.

2. Practical impacts of the suspension are:

- a. **No Vouching:** Personnel with valid DoW identification (service members, dependents over 16, and DoW employees) can no longer "vouch" for passengers in their vehicles.
- b. **100% ID Checks:** Every individual in a vehicle must now present a valid DoW ID card or a base pass to gain entry.
- c. **Visitor Procedures:** Anyone without a valid DoW credential must visit the installation's Visitor Control Center (VCC) to be vetted and issued a temporary pass.
- d. **Real ID Requirement:** All visitors must present a valid **REAL ID-compliant identification** (e.g., state-issued driver's license or passport) to be issued a pass.
- e. **Expect Delays:** Bases are warning of significant wait times at both the gates and visitor centers due to these manual 100% ID checks.

3. Additional implementation details:

- a. **Force Protection Condition (FPCON):** While specific FPCON measures have been increased, USNORTHCOM stated there is no known specific threat to any individual installation.
- b. **Installation Authority:** Local commanders retain the authority to add supplemental measures based on their specific mission and local threat assessments.
- c. **Monitor Public Advisories:** Government offices and TSPs should monitor official channels such as the USNORTHCOM Newsroom or their specific installation's website for real-time updates and details on gate closures or processing delays.
