SUBJECT: RESULTS OF FY22 STATEWIDE SCIENCE AND END-OF-COURSE (EOC) ASSESSMENTS FOR BIOLOGY 1, CIVICS, AND U.S. HISTORY

The Florida Department of Education (FDOE) has released the FY22 results of the Statewide Science Assessments and Next Generation Sunshine State Standards (NGSSS) EOC assessments for Biology 1, Civics, and U.S. History.¹ This document provides a high-level summary of the performance for the District, the Seven Largest Florida Districts, and the State overall. Scores from FY19 (pre-pandemic), FY21, and FY22 (released today) are included. Statewide, scores in all subject areas declined in FY22 relative to FY19, the last time the statewide exams were administered prior to the COVID-19 pandemic. A preliminary review of the test results revealed:

- On the Statewide Science Assessment, the District's performance was unchanged in FY22 compared to FY21 and was lower than pre-pandemic performance.
 - Fifth grade students, scoring at 44% Level 3 or above, performed lower than their peers statewide (48%).
 - Eighth grade students, scoring at 47% Level 3 or above, performed slightly higher than the State (45%).

With regard to the EOC exams, the District and the State overall showed lower performance relative to pre-pandemic levels.

- Biology 1—the District scored at 62%, a decrease of 1 point from FY21, and remained 7 points below pre-pandemic levels (similar to statewide performance). The District tied two of the other Seven Largest Florida Districts for highest performance in FY22.
- Civics—the District scored at 68%, an improvement of 6 points from FY21, remaining 4 points below pre-pandemic levels, and nearly tied the State (69%).
- U.S. History—the District scored at 66%, an increase of 5 points from FY21, and exceeded the State by 1 point. The District remains 3 points below pre-pandemic levels.
