FORT LAURENS Museum, Ohio's only Revolutionary War fort, was built in 1778 during an ill-fated campaign to attack the British at Detroit. The fort was abandoned in 1779. Today, a museum houses artifacts and displays, and an informational videos shares the story of the War for Independence and the Fort Laurens campaign.

The grounds feature a large public park with multiple pavilions and monuments standing in honor of those who fought and died for American Independence.

WHAT TO DO

SCHOENBRUNN Village (“Beautiful Spring”) was founded in 1772, where over 300 Delaware Native Americans and Moravian missionaries drew up Ohio’s first civil code and build its first Christian church and schoolhouse. The Village serves as a window into Ohio’s past and a fascinating perspective on the American Revolution.

Today, the reconstructed village contains 16 log buildings, gardens, and the original mission cemetery. The visitor center features artifacts from archaeological digs, and re-enactors bring this unique community to life.
