Privacy Waiver Authorizing Disclosure to a Third Party:

The ICE Form 60-001: Privacy Waiver Authorizing Disclosure to a Third Party

The form gives the Office of Congresswoman Schakowsky (or another third party like a lawyer) permission to request and receive information on your behalf, as our constituent. It allows the Office to request information about constituents when their case involves Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) and Customs and Border Protection (CBP). The Congresswoman's Office takes your privacy and safety seriously and will NEVER request or share information about your case without a release form that gives us permission.

Families may opt to fill out the form in advance as part of their family preparedness and safety planning. The sections below with the red arrows must be filled out by the person at risk of ICE detention.

Step 1:

Ensure that these sections are filled out:

A-Number (A#), Case number, if available

Full name

Date of Birth

Country of Origin

Step 2:

If you are giving the Office of Congresswoman Schakowsky permission to request and receive information on your behalf:

Signature of the loved one at risk of detention signs but DOES NOT DATE the form if it is being preemptively filled out prior to being detained. Office staff will instruct you when to complete the date section

Note: The privacy waiver can also be requested by a constituent in ICE custody should they be detained by ICE, but the form availability may vary depending on where the constituent is taken into custody. Therefore, we encourage the form to be completed in advance, as part of safety and family preparedness planning.
