What services are available?

Services through the IDOA's Community Care Program can include homemaker assistance (such as help with meals, laundry, or errands), adult day services (structured activities and care outside the home), and emergency response systems.

Who is eligible?

To qualify, a person must be:

- 60 or older
- U.S. citizen or legal resident
- Illinois resident
- Have non-exempt assets of \$17,500 or less (this does not include things like a home, car, or burial arrangements)
- Have a demonstrated need for help with daily living activities, determined through an in-home assessment by the IDOA

We work with seniors of all backgrounds and are committed to helping people access the care they need to stay safe and independent.
