**Liquid assets** available to meet expenses totaled \$89,378 on 7/31/2021 (excludes dedicated funds).

**Offering income** was \$3,713 more than budgeted for July and is \$2,771 less than budgeted YTD.

**Preschool net income** was \$18,475 more than budgeted for July and is \$27,362 more than budgeted YTD. We have reached full enrollment for September. Currently 134 are enrolled for Fall.

**Other Receipts** included specified gifts of \$54 for the Facility Maintenance Fund, \$1,625 for the Food Bank, \$25 for Siloe, \$100 for ELCA Disaster Relief, \$100 for Good Samaritan Fund, and \$100 for ELCA World Hunger Fund.

**Non-Preschool Operating Expenses** were \$3,107 less than budgeted for July and are \$3,296 less than budgeted YTD. All expense categories were less than budgeted for the month or within \$150 of budget.

**Notable:** \$10,000 was transferred from the preschool proceeds into the Facility Maintenance Fund. This money was used to cover the bills related to a roof/stucco/gutter repair in the preschool classroom building.




## What are Stephen Ministers?

"Stephen Ministers are laypeople trained to provide one-on-one, Christ-centered care. They provide care to individuals facing difficult times in life—grief, cancer, divorce, financial difficulties, hospitalization, chronic illness, job loss, disability, loneliness, a spiritual crisis, or other life struggles – sounds familiar in these trying times of the COVID-19 pandemic. Stephen Ministers have a compassionate heart for those who are hurting and are equipped with caring ministry skills learned through an intense training regimen administered by our congregation's Stephen Leaders. A Stephen Minister has one care receiver at a time and meets with that person regularly to listen, care, pray, encourage and offer emotional and spiritual support in a confidential, non-judgmental atmosphere.



Community Lutheran has had a standing presence in Stephen Ministry since the early 2000's. You'd be surprised how many in the congregation have trained to be a Stephen Minister since that time. There is currently a cadre of active Stephen Ministers who generally meet on the second and fourth Tuesday of each month for what is called Peer Supervision. These sessions include support for each other in our caring ministry relationships and for the opportunity for continuing education on related subjects to make us better Stephen Ministers.

If you or someone you know could benefit from a relationship with a Stephen Minister, please ask any of our Stephen Leaders for more information. If Stephen Ministry is of interest to you as an outreach for your time and talents, we encourage you to explore your heart and consider joining us in becoming a Stephen Minister in the future."
