WHAT TO EXPECT

The expert team will start with an on-site assessment to evaluate the current IPC facility practices. Each facility is unique, and the team will support staff in targeted areas, as well as the following:

- Reviewing facility-wide environment of care practices (hand hygiene, shared-resident equipment, environmental services, laundry, food services, transmission-based precautions, enhanced-barrier precautions).
- Directly observing facility practices.
- Offering supportive coaching when IPC gaps are identified.
- Providing a mock F880 survey.
- Evaluating infectious disease outbreak specific practices (as needed and appropriate).
- Providing a detailed report along with resources to assist you in implementing evidence-based IPC practices.
