Dr. JJ Ferguson, PT, DPT, DScPTAssociate Professor
Fellow of the American Academy of Orthopaedic Manual Physical Therapy
Board Certified Clinical Specialist in Orthopaedic Physical Therapy
Board Certified Clinical Specialist in Sports Physical Therapy

JJ Ferguson is an associate professor at Bellin College in the Doctor of Physical Therapy Program. He is from Drayton, ND and graduated from the University of North Dakota's (UND) Physical Therapy Program. He was UND's first physical therapy sports resident. His clinical expertise and training are orthopedics, manual therapy, and sports. He has achieved board certification in sports and orthopedics and is recognized as a Fellow of the American Academy of Orthopaedic Manual Physical Therapists. He completed his Doctor of Science in Physical Therapy through Bellin College. He has an interest in phenomenological analysis of musculoskeletal conditions and client experiences in healthcare. He has an interest in physical therapist burnout and has published on how they perceive and manage job stressors. Dr. Ferguson has presented at several national and state conferences including the APTA's Combined Sections Meeting and the American Academy of Orthopaedic Manual Physical Therapy.
