Cathedral Choristers are part of a centuries-old tradition of children singing the top line of inter-generational choral music—the way Bach, Handel, Mozart and so many other composers first heard their music performed. Sing three Sundays a month at Cathedral services (9 am rehearsal for a 10 am service). Have regular concert opportunities such as performing in the Cathedral Arts concert series and collaborating with other choirs and orchestra.

For ages 7½ to 15.

What a Child Can Expect...

- Making new friends who are as excited about singing as you are
- Choir camp in August, including a team-building challenge course, swimming, great food, and bonfires
- Singing the world's greatest choral music in its original form, not simplified versions for a "children's choir"
- Rehearsing Thursdays from 5:30 to 7:45 - dinner included! - and singing an average of three performances per month, plus a weekly 20-minute private lesson which can be done online
- Touring in Newport, Rhode Island in November 2026
- We pay you! A stipend is paid for rehearsals and performances based on your attendance and level. Stipends range from \$12 up to \$40 per month

What a Parent Can Expect...

- Refocus your child off the couch and off screens
- Brain power! A choral education teaches problem solving, spatial reasoning, cooperation, and an appreciation of excellence, along with patience, in a rare inter-generational experience where children and adults learn and perform together
- Community: parents will find themselves part of an extended and vital "choir family," proud of the whole team's accomplishments
- Thanks to the Cathedral's generous supporters, there is no tuition fee for a training value worth several thousand dollars of music lessons a year. Fees are required for camp and some trips with scholarship aid available
