Interpretive Guide

A visitor experience focused opportunity, interpretive guides are a rewarding position for someone passionate about history! Working with site staff, you will conduct guided tours of the historic site during special events or on regularly scheduled tour days. Guides can also help staff with activities for field trips throughout the year.

Events Assistant

In this position, you assist with special events by providing visitor information services, assist site staff with activities, and event set-up and cleanup. These tasks may include physical labor, administrative assistance, and working with the public. Special events assistants will be needed weekends and evenings throughout the year. They also help with public programs through living history and special tours.

Gardeners

Gardeners help to maintain the various interpretive gardens at our sites, as well as landscaping and beautification by weeding, planting, and caring for flower beds around the historic structures. A great opportunity if you like to work with plants, or outdoors in general.

Junior Preservationists (13-18)

You will experience amazing opportunities and go behind the scenes of local historic sites. Our Junior Preservationists work with historians and historic interpreters doing many of the same jobs performed by adult volunteers with consideration for age. You'll have the chance to assist staff with special events, summer camps, education programs, and the daily operations of our many historic sites!
