

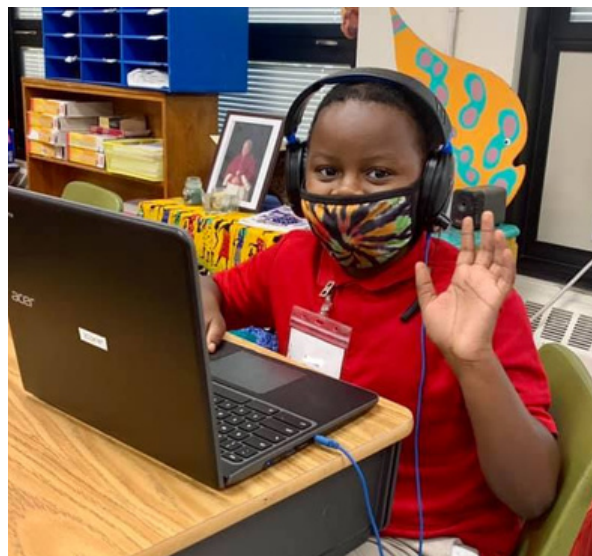


SNAPSHOT: COMMITTEE HIGHLIGHTS
