Thornton received \$1.5 million in WaterSMART grant funds from the Bureau of Reclamation to implement new technologies to improve water services citywide.




Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) is capable of collecting and reporting water use data in real-time, providing timely information about water usage to both the city and water customers.

YOUR WATER SUPPLY IN THE NY TIMES

David Gelles of the NY Times traveled to Colorado earlier this year to talk with officials, landowners, developers, and business owners about water scarcity and its effects. Previous and current city officials from Thornton were on his interview list.

"In the water business you have to be years and years ahead of the game," said Jack Ethredge, now retired City Manager. Almost 40-years after securing water rights, Thornton is tackling the challenges of installing a 70-mile pipeline.



The [NY Times article](#) provides different perspectives but clearly states that most neighboring communities agree that the city has a legal right to access their water. So, Thornton is working on a revised route for the pipeline in hopes of a swift resolution.
