Council members will gain skills such as leadership, collaboration, and project management as they plan and execute a community engagement project that benefits their community and our most vulnerable populations.

Youth Council applicants must be in high school (public, private or home school) and reside in Nevada for the entirety of the 24-25 school year to complete the full term of service (June 2024 - May 2025)

The objective of this council is to provide Nevada youth the opportunity to be civically engaged, become responsible citizens, and gain skills that lead to a positive self identity, and connections to community, family & peers.

All high school students interested in serving on the 2024-2025 Youth Council should complete and submit this application no later than April 19, 2024 at 11:59pm.

Members may be eligible for a stipend of \$400 upon completion of their service.
