Personal Dignity Kit “PDK” (\$15 Value)



- 1 Bath Hand Towel - No kitchen towels
- 1 Bath Washcloth - No kitchen dishcloths
- 1 Comb - sturdy - No rattail or picks
- 1 Razor - with guard
- 1 Nail Clippers - No nail files or emery boards
- 10 Band-Aids - 3/4" x 3"
- 1 Adult Toothbrush - No multipacks
- 1 Toothpaste - 2.5 oz. or larger
- 1 Bar Soap - 3-4 oz.
- 1 Shampoo - 15-18 oz.
- 1 Deodorant - 2-3 oz. - stick, roll on, or pump
- Place items in 1-gallon resealable plastic bag

Tornado Kit (\$50 Value)



- 2 Pairs Work Gloves
- 24 1-gallon resealable bags
- 2 Permanent Markers
- 1 Roll Duct Tape - prefer colored
- 2 Dust Masks - No surgical
- 24 Trash Bags - heavy duty - 33-45 gallon size
- 24 Clear / White Trash Bags - 20-33 gallon size
- \$20 Donation for 2 totes - 18 gallon

Student Kit (\$16 Value)



- 3 Notebooks - 1 subject spiral 8"x 10 1/2"
- 1 Ruler - 12" long with metric
- 6 Pencils - unsharpened
- 1 Pencil Sharpener
- 1 Pencil Eraser - 2" or larger
- 1 Box 12 Colored Pencils
- 1 Box 24 Crayons
- 1 Pair of Scissors - student

Layette Kit (\$45 Value)



- 6 Cloth Diapers
- 2 Gowns or Sleepers
- 2 Onesies or Undershirts
- 2 Infant Washcloths - No adult washcloths
- 6 Diaper Pins - must have protective plastic closures
- 1 Sweater, Sweatshirt or Jacket - knitted, crocheted or sewn with front opening - No ties or buttons
- 2 Receiving Blankets - 28"x 28" to 32"x 32" - No crib, fleece or thermal blankets
- Bundle items inside one of the blankets and secure with diaper pins
- \$2 Donation for diaper cream

Birthing Kit (\$9 Value)



- 1 Bar Soap - 3-4 oz.
- 1 Pair Gloves - surgical or thin rubber gloves
- 1 Square Yard Clear Plastic Sheeting - 4 mil thick - No trash bags or shower curtains
- 3 Pieces Cotton String - each 12" long - No yarn
- 1 Razor Blade - single edge - cover in paper or cardboard to prevent injury
- 2 Receiving Blankets - 28"x 28" to 32"x 32" - No crib, fleece or thermal blankets
- Place items in 1-gallon resealable plastic bag

Feminine Hygiene Kit (\$40 Value)



- 1 One Handle Cloth Bag (Instructions on website)
- 2 1-Gallon Resealable Plastic Bags
- 1 Washcloth
- 1 Bar Soap 3-4 oz.
- 3 Pairs of Underwear - sizes: child 10, 12, 14 / women- 5, 6, 8
- 6 Day Pads and 3 Night Pads (Patterns on website)

Medical equipment and supplies: are donated and typically sent internationally.
