

Reut Noyman joined the IMPJ in 2016 as head of the Jewish Peoplehood Education Center (in Hebrew known as Yachdav), and since May 2018 is serving as the Acting Director of the IMPJ Education Department.

Reut grew up in Petach Tikvah where she completed high school. She served in the IDF as a combat instructor in the armored corps (tanks) and was a graduate of the first ever mixed gender IDF combat officer's course. She also served in a number of special combat operations units as an instructor. Today she serves in the IDF reserves as a combat planner and instructor. During the Protective Edge Operation in the summer of 2014, Reut was involved in instruction activities for reserve armored corps units in their preparations to enter the Gaza strip. Today Reut continues her duty in the IDF reserves at the rank of Captain. After completing her mandatory IDF service Reut studied at Haifa University and has a BA in Education and Communication, a Teaching Credential, and later achieved a double Master's Degree in degree in American Jewish Studies, and Alternative Education.

For 5 years, Reut was a high school teacher in The Hebrew Reali School in Haifa where she taught Communications, Public Diplomacy, and Information Technologies and was the Head of International Leadership Program. At the same time, she was a Project Director for the Youth at Risk Center in Haifa Israel, connected with Israeli Scouts Movement.

For 6 summers, Reut served as a Sh'lichah in different summer camps through the Jewish Agency for Israel including:

- Assistant Summer Camp Director at Betty and Milton Katz JCC, Margate, New Jersey
- Educator and head of the Israeli delegation at Camp Coleman (URJ), Cleveland, Georgia
- Head of Israel culture and head of the Israeli delegation at Dave and Mary Alper JCC, South Miami-Dade County, Florida

She also was a Guest Sh'lichah, for Israel's 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary, JCC South Miami-Dade County, Florida and a long term Sh'lichah, MAKOM Program "Destination: Israel," Federation South Miami-Dade County, Florida .

Reut is active in volunteer work with an NGO helping the elderly through work with pets.
