We're excited to invite you to join the **Celebrate Research Week (CRW) 2025** campaign. This national movement aims to elevate the role of research in shaping health, economy, environment, and communities in Canada.

Led by the Osler Research Institute for Health Innovation (ORIHI), the 2024 CRW proclamation celebrated the launch of both ORIHI and the TMU School of Medicine, while highlighting the Brampton's innovators. This year, we are joining with national partners to encourage researchers, academic institutions, health organizations, research networks, and innovation hubs across the country to amplify the importance of research in public life, policy, and everyday wellbeing with a cross-Canada advocacy campaign.

This toolkit provides all the essentials you'll need to bring CRW to life in your region. Whether you're hosting a community event, an online talk, organizing a research fair, or simply advocating for municipal recognition, this is your opportunity to personalize the message and make research visible, valued, and vibrant in your community. Some of you may already have a research events planned at another time in the year, however we ask that you still consider taking the CRW proclamation request to your local city hall to proclaim November 17-21, 2025 as CRW and make this a cross-Canada celebration.

By coordinating these activities during the same week, we seek to ensure research is not only celebrated, but understood as essential to Canada's present and future.

Celebrate Research Week Objectives

The objectives of Celebrate Research Week (CRW) are to:

- Elevate the visibility of research.
- Showcase the importance of research across disciplines in improving health, policy, innovation, and everyday life.
- Counter misinformation and promote public trust in science and research.
- Advocate for funding and policy support of research.
- Demonstrate the impact of research to decision makers at all levels.
- Encourage sustained investment in both academic and applied research.
- Foster local and national engagement.
- Connect communities with the research taking place around them.
- Include the public in conversations about research and it's benefits.
- Unite researchers across Canada in a national movement through coordinated messaging, events, and advocacy.
- Share resources and celebrate local successes to build collective momentum.

Key Messages & Media Templates

Celebrate Research Week (CRW) is a national opportunity to showcase how research improves lives, strengthens communities, and shapes a better future. Whether you're in health, environment, education, or technology, CRW is a platform to spotlight how research addresses pressing challenges.

You can use core messages like "Research is the foundation of innovation that drives progress in our communities" to guide your storytelling and public engagement. Media outreach plays a critical role in amplifying these messages and a regional proclamation also acts as a hook. By connecting with local newspapers, campus outlets, radio stations, and community blogs, you help bring research into everyday conversations.

Public support for research grows when people see its impact on their lives, so we encourage you to tailor and share the messages that resonate most with your community.

A fill-in-the-blank media release template will be available to help you pitch your story, promote your event, and call the public to join in CRW activities.

If your organization has a media relations or communications team, work closely with them to coordinate these efforts. Also, ensure you connect with other research organizations in your region to align messaging.

Action: Use the media release template to adapt it to your region, including quotes from spokespeople, researchers and representatives. Adapt it to reflect your unique strengths in research, innovation, and community development.



Municipal Proclamation

Municipal proclamations are ceremonial recognitions issued by the Mayor to highlight events or causes that positively contribute to the community's wellbeing.

We encourage organizations to collaborate on a joint proclamation request for CRW. If a joint submission is not possible, organizations may include a note asking the municipality to consider grouping all CRW proclamations submitted in the region into a unified recognition.

Objective: To have municipalities across Canada proclaim Celebrate Research Week November 17-21, 2025.

Submitting a Proclamation Request for Celebrate Research Week

- CRW qualifies as a recognized public awareness campaign.
- Proclamation requests may only be submitted by non-profit or charitable organizations.
- Submit your request through the municipality's official online proclamation request form, if available.
- To ensure adequate preparation time, we recommend submitting by September 15. This
 allows for scheduling for a delegation to be present when the proclamation is read in
 council chambers. This is a media opportunity.
- Include background information outlining the purpose and importance of CRW (<u>A</u> downloadable template is available to assist with this step.)
- Proclamation requests must be submitted on an annual basis. (Get a head start on CRW 2026!)
- All proclamations are granted at the discretion of the Mayor and are not guaranteed.

Action: Use the suggested proclamation in this toolkit to request official recognition of CRW from your local mayor or city council. Adapt it to reflect your city's unique strengths in research, innovation, and community development.



Provincial and Federal Advocacy

Provincial Proclamations

Provinces may issue proclamations through the office of the Premier, a Minister, or the Speaker of the Legislature.

We encourage research institutions and community champions to work with provincial representatives (e.g., MPPs) to have Celebrate Research Week officially recognized at the provincial level.

Instructions for Provincial Advocacy

- Find your local MPP at this website: https://www.ola.org/en/members/current
- Reach out to your local representative with a customized letter of request and background materials.
- Emphasize the provincial impact of research and innovation, including how it strengthens health, education, environment, and the economy.
- A sample letter and request template are available to download

Action: Begin conversations with provincial contacts as early as possible to align with legislative timelines.

Federal Proclamation and National Engagement

Celebrate Research Week (CRW) is also being championed at the federal level to promote national awareness and recognition of Canadian research excellence.

Federal-Level Plans

- A federal proclamation request will be submitted to align with the national campaign.
- CRW 2025 will culminate with a national reading of the proclamation at the Canadian Science Policy Conference in Ottawa (November 19–21, 2025).

Instructions for Federal Engagement

- Local members are encouraged to contact their MPs and collaborate with national partners to support the federal initiative.
- Highlight the importance of research to Canada's future in areas such as healthcare, innovation, climate resilience, and economic growth.

Action: Use the federal letter-writing template in this toolkit to express your support of CRW to your local MP.



Public Outreach Events for Celebrate Research Week

Why Public Events Matter

Celebrate Research Week (CRW) is not only about formal proclamations, it's also an opportunity to connect with our communities, showcase the value of research, and build trust in science and innovation.

Hosting outreach events during CRW helps demonstrate how research impacts real lives. This includes all research from health and education to technology, the environment, and public policy. These events offer a platform to make research visible, accessible, and relevant to communities across Canada.

Join the National Conversation.

CRW Events

Choose a format that fits your audience and local context. Events can be large or small, in-person or virtual.

- Research Fairs / Open Houses.
- Welcome the public into labs, research institutes, or universities to explore current projects and innovations.
- Café Scientifique or talks in the community.
- Host informal discussions between researchers and the public in cafes, libraries, or community centres.
- Inspire the next generation with school visits, interactive workshops, or student-led panels on topics that matter to youth.
- Science-Art Exhibitions: Use art, performance, or multimedia to express scientific ideas in creative ways.
- Highlight the role of research in your region through guided tours of tech hubs, health centres, hospital research areas or environmental field sites.
- Research-to-Policy Dialogues: Bring researchers and policymakers together to discuss evidencebased approaches to local or national challenges.

Timeline & Action Plan

- Sept 2025 Plan and promote local outreach events
- Oct 2025 Launch CRW event page please share events (e.g., LinkedIn events)
- Oct 2025 Coordinate logistics, send media releases, confirm proclamations, prepare for national CRW promotion campaign
- Nov 17–21, 2025 CRW Kick-off and event week (e.g., Host a public event)
- Nov 19–21, 2025 Canadian Science Policy Conference and National Proclamation
