Great and Holy Lent is meant to serve as a time for spiritual growth and enrichment for us as Orthodox Christians. With the blessings of Fr. James Rousakis, Vicar of the Tampa Bay Area, St. John Greek Orthodox Church in Tampa is again proud to announce the SIXTEENTH ANNUAL GOYA LENTEN ADVENTURE. This year's Lenten Retreat will be held on **March 27-29** (This weekend was chosen to work around the Greek Independence Day Parade, Greek School Programs and SAT's, Pascha is April 19 this year). The program will begin approximately 6:00 p.m. on Friday evening, March 27 and will conclude with a luncheon following Divine Liturgy on Sunday, March 29.

Hotel Accommodations have been secured at the Four Points by Sheraton Suites, located approximately 3.5 miles from St. John. Please make your reservations directly with the Four Points Sheraton Hotel by March 9, the cut-off date. They are holding many rooms for us and will do so until that date. The rooms sleep up to six people (each room has a roll-away couch, and if you ask for two double beds or two queens, you end up with room for 6) for the low cost of **\$129 per night**, (no tax if you use church check with tax ID number provided. When you make a reservation, ask for two queen beds. Each room also has a sofa bed so rooms can sleep up to six). *Because the program includes events on Friday night and runs late into the evening of Saturday, it is hoped that with this low price, everyone will be able to stay at the hotel. It is also a beautiful thing for our teens to all worship together at the Divine Liturgy on Sunday morning.* The Four Points by Sheraton Suites is one of the best hotels in Tampa. *When you call the hotel, the group name is "St. John's Baptist Retreat March 2020"*

SIXTEENTH ANNUAL GOYA LENTEN ADVENTURE: "Teach Us to Pray"

Service Project 2020

This year once again, we will be helping Love INC of Metro Tampa and their member organizations as a part of our Lenten Retreat. We will be doing the following things:

1. We will build Bike Accessory Bags consisting of: Adult Helmet, Combination bike lock, Bike Lights and a bag for **God's Pedal Power Ministry**. Since 2017, Bethesda Ministries, part of 34th Street COG, has operated its God's Pedal Power Ministry (GPPM) out of its owned property located at 3301 E 22nd Avenue Tampa, FL 3365. This 1,500 square foot, three-bedroom home is used for a variety of service ministries of Bethesda Ministries, including their food pantry and GPPM, to **collect, store, repair and distribute refurbished bicycles to qualified referrals in need**. These items will be purchased by St. John's.
2. We will build Hygiene Kits for **The Coffee Shop**. For over 25 years, Gracepoint Wellness operated The Coffee Shop, affectionately known by those struggling with homelessness as, "The Shop" located on 6220 North Nebraska Avenue, Tampa, FL 33604. It provides a single point of entry for 100 (per day) of our homeless neighbors to receive case management, escape Florida's elements, do laundry, shower, receive mail, telephone/Internet access, get a photo ID, have a mailing address, and simply enjoy a cup of coffee. Most importantly, The Shop was often the first step to begin building a trusting relationship to engage into services and hopefully off the streets. To God be the glory!



We need each group to bring enough of the following travel size items for 20 bags:

Shampoo, conditioner, bar soap/shower gel, deodorant men's / women's, disposable razor, shave foam, hand sanitizer, Kleenex tissues, lip gloss, tooth brush, tooth paste, dental floss, wet wipes, 3 laundry pods.
