LIQUID (NOT GEL) HAND SANITIZER AVAILABLE FOR DONATION FROM ExxonMobil in Baton Rouge

- ExxonMobil is making medical-grade hand sanitizer at its Baton Rouge Chemical Plant, which has the world's single largest unit producing isopropyl alcohol.
 - Produced under [FDA guidance](#) (IPA-based)
 - This is not a gel-type hand sanitizer – it has the consistency of water
 - The hand sanitizer is appropriate for first responders, medical professionals, etc.

 - IBC (intermediate bulk container): ~320 gallons per IBC (this is the preferred packaging method)
 - Pallet of 5-gal pails (48 pails per pallet)
 - Box of 1-quart bottles (12 bottles per box)
