- **The Federal Register Notice for the Solicitation of Nominations** for Appointment to the Advisory Committee on Minority Health (ACMH) has been published. Click on the link to read the notice or click on the attachment. There are a total of four impending vacancies on the Committee: Three vacancies on the ACMH that impact the representation for the health interests of Hispanics/Latinos and one vacancy that impacts the representation of Asian Americans, Native Hawaiians, and other Pacific Islanders. OMH is particularly seeking nominations for individuals who can represent the health interests of these racial and ethnic minority groups. Nominations that are received for individuals to represent other racial and ethnic minority groups also will be accepted. These applications will be retained in files that are maintained by OMH on potential candidates to be considered for the ACMH.

- **National Dairy Council GenYouth Representative from NHMA-** National Dairy Council is hosting their Health & Wellness Advisory Council meeting in DC on December 13-14. Representatives are needed for this meeting as well as future meetings with the council.

Residents

- The **HIVMA Clinical Fellowship program** supports newly trained physicians with gaining HIV clinical experience working with medically underserved patient populations. The goal of the program is to boost the population of HIV physicians and strengthen the commitment to provide clinical care to HIV-infected patients in minority communities. HIVMA awards grants to support one-year of HIV clinical training to up to two fellows per year. Grants are made to the institution

to support a stipend of \$60,000 plus additional funding to cover fringe benefits for one year. An additional \$10,000 is paid to the institution to offset administrative costs and to provide for additional educational opportunities. Applications for the 2018-2019 program are now being accepted. The deadline to apply is January 8, 2018. Strong preference will be given to African American and Latino candidates and to applicants pursuing training in the Southeastern U.S.
