

NHMA endorses EARLY Act to Reauthorization of 2019

Congresswoman Debbie Wasserman Schultz (FL-23) and Congresswoman Susan Brooks (IN-05) introduced H.R. 4078 to reauthorize and increase funding for the Breast Cancer Education and Awareness Learning Young Act (EARLY) Act on July 26. The EARLY Act, which became law in 2010, has created education and outreach campaign administered by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) that discusses breast cancer risk that face young women and certain women who are at a higher risk due to their ethnic and racial background.
