I want to do more than manage diseases; I want to help people be healthy.


I want to impact the health of my entire community.

In an effort to bring essential and specialty health care services to more Mississippians, we've established satellite hospitals in Grenada and Lexington and implemented the state's most comprehensive telehealth program, with over 35 kinds of specialty care across more than 100 clinical sites.
