Purpose: The purpose of the Board of medical Assistance Services is to ensure that the categorically and medically needy citizens of the Commonwealth have financial access to a cost effective, comprehensive health care delivery system.

Composition: The Board shall be composed of eleven residents of the Commonwealth, five of whom are health care providers and six of whom are not, all to be appointed by the Governor, subject to confirmation by the General Assembly. The board annually elects a chairman from its members.
