Sanbornton, NH	Y	1) The sale of PAYT bags and tags is suspended . If residents run out of tags, just throw the trash can just throw MSW away upon the honor system 2) Only recycling and household waste will be accepted. Residents asked to hold demolition material, metal, oil, televisions 3) Recycling building closed - outside container available for recycling 4) One car at a time to deposit recyclables 5) Buildings closed to public
