Since then, membership in the NRRA has grown to include over 400+ municipalities, individuals, and businesses in New Hampshire, Vermont, Massachusetts, Connecticut, Rhode Island and Maine. The NRRA is nationally recognized as an innovative grassroots organization with competitive pricing, enabling small, rural and large urban communities to manage their own recycling programs. Last year NRRA members sent over 10,000 tons of recyclables per week to market through the NRRA!
