Dates: July 10-17, 2026

For: All Students who are currently in 8th-12th grade
Cost: \$895

There are fundraising opportunities for this trip.

Payment Dates: Deposit of \$150 when registered February 1st (\$100), March 1st(\$100), April 12th (\$100), May 3rd (\$100),

June 7th (\$345 or remaining balance)

Adults: We will be bringing church-approved adult leaders for this trip. Students will be with one of our leaders at all times.

Transportation: We will be flying (students and leaders 18+ will need either a

real ID or passport to fly) and renting vans.

HOW TO SIGN UP: Turn in your non-refundable **deposit (\$150)** along with your **registration form** to the Student Ministries Department Office or drop it off in the steel box outside the SM Office .

Envision Twin Cities, located in the Minneapolis and Saint Paul area, exists to create partnerships and environments that transform and empower refugees and other immigrants.

The Twin Cities have become home to many displaced people groups. 1 out of 3 people in the Twin Cities are first or second-generation immigrants. There are refugees in Minnesota from Somalia, Burma, Iraq, Ethiopia, Bhutan, Congo, Ukraine, Syria, Liberia, the former Soviet Union, Afghanistan and more. There are an estimated 83,000 Somali People in the Twin Cities - more than anywhere else in the country. St. Paul has the largest Hmong Community in the United States. The Liberian Population in the Twin Cities is one of the largest in America. St. Paul has a growing population of Karen, a minority group from Burma, currently the largest in the USA.

We love that you are joining us in equipping and assisting churches to reach out to refugee communities with the love of Jesus Christ in the Twin Cities.

The purpose of Envision Twin Cities is to create partnerships and environments that transform and empower refugees and other immigrants.

Culture

Over 100 different languages are spoken in the public schools. Many of these students call a language other than English their home language. Many that we connect with speak English as a second language and are 1st or 2nd generation immigrants to the US. We must keep in mind the diverse background that our community has. Even though you are in the US, this will be a cross-cultural experience. We recommend coming in with a posture of a listener and learner. Your interactions will have a long-term impact on the relationships we are building here on the ground, so be thoughtful with them.

Safety

Safety is of utmost importance. Every precaution is taken to create a safe and healthy environment for students to encounter God and serve him. While our students will likely split into ministry teams to serve, each team will have a GCAC Leader present with them at all times. All GCAC Leaders and Envision employees have been vetted and have completed all required background checks.

<u>Housing</u>

Our team will be hosted on the campus of North Central University.

<u>Ministry</u>

Our students will be getting a well-rounded experience with all that Envision Twin Cities has to offer. This is a diverse, holistic ministry that incorporates three elements: ministry, service, and training. Students will jump into Refugee and Immigrant outreach, Sports Ministry, Youth and Children's Ministry and work in the Community Garden.

Medical Info

Each student must have health insurance and provide a copy of their insurance card. Each student should have an up-to-date tetanus booster. Oasis SM requires a completed AYP for the 2025-2026 ministry year. Envision has additional paperwork at registration.

Necessary Requirements

In addition to Oasis SM application, Envision requires participants to register with them and provide documents- health insurance, liability waiver, etc. There is also a child safety video that each participant must watch.

Adult leaders and Student participants 18+ must complete a background check within a year of the trip date. Information to complete this step will be sent when you registration is received.

Financial Details

Our Estimated Cost: \$895

This will include registration, a team shirt, meals, transportation, etc.

Student Account:

A student account will be established for each student that registers for the trip. This account will house money your student has fundraised or collected for their Envision Twin Cities journey. Donations from parents, family, and friends can be received in this account. These donations are tax-deductible.

Fundraisers:

We will be planning several fundraisers to help offset some of the costs for this trip. We believe that if you work hard at each of these fundraisers, you could expect to raise around half of the cost and then you would be responsible to pay the other half or find a job for which to earn the funds.
