Federal, State and Local Issues Essential to Older Adults Will Be Discussed at Legislative Breakfasts

Federal budget issues, changes to the Affordable Care Act, simplifying Medicare Part B enrollment, Illinois budget issues, Adult Protective Services, Cook County budget issues and other topics essential to older adults and those who care for them will be discussed at the 2018 Legislative Breakfasts in January and February.

AgeOptions, in partnership with community-based senior service agencies, convenes the breakfasts each year. Constituents and representatives of local agencies serving older adults share information with federal, state, Cook County and local officials. For the officials and their representatives, the breakfasts are an opportunity to discuss older adult services and issues facing older adults, and hear how they and those who serve older people can support each other.
