This June 2022, the Pennsylvania Office of International Business Development will be supporting the **2022 'Virtual' Trade Mission to Australia and New Zealand.**

The program will be organized and run by the Authorized Trade Representative for Pennsylvania in the region, and will take place across two weeks, from 13 - 24 June.

As a participant, you will receive the following:

- A virtual consultation with the trade office where they can talk to you about the virtual program, your product, service and potential opportunities.
- A Market Assessment tailored to your specific product, service or request.
- A **Virtual Matchmaking Program** tailored to your ideal partner or distributor profile. It will be completed as:

Stage I: the trade office in Sydney will draw up an initial list of potential partners / distributors for your review, based on your ideal partner criteria.

Stage II: pending your review, the trade office in Sydney will approach each of the shortlisted potential partners / distributors on your behalf to introduce your company, product or service and coordinate a virtual meeting with interested parties to take place between 13 - 24 June.

WHY AUSTRALIA & NEW ZEALAND

Australia (and New Zealand) is a major export market for the US, and Pennsylvania in particular. In 2020, total merchandise exports from Pennsylvania to Australia and New Zealand (ANZ) was worth **~US\$670.2 million**.

Key exports from Pennsylvania to Australia include machinery, chemicals, transportation equipment, electrical products, manufactured food products.

Based on our 20+ years experience assisting Pennsylvania in this region (incl. several virtual trade programs delivered throughout the COVID19 pandemic), we believe there is opportunity in the market across a wide range of sectors, including but not limited to: mining equipment, medical devices and consumables, food & beverage, SaaS, water & wastewater equipment, construction & manufacturing equipment, consumer retail.

Deadline: April 8, 2022

Registration fee: \$3,500 per company*+

- FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE of up to \$10,000 may be available to qualifying companies to offset missionrelated costs.
- Registration fee will be paid directly to the commonwealth's Trade Representative Office in Sydney via wire transfer.
