Fall Soccer Update

Good afternoon,
I hope that the start of the school year has gone well for you all. I wanted to reach out with an update on the KCC's Fall Soccer program.

The program will run on Saturdays, September 26-October 24th and will be held at Shapleigh field. We will be working with Challenger Soccer Academy this season. They will have a staff member on site each week as a supervisor and to help volunteers facilitate skills and drills. The focus will be on fun and early skill development. The sessions will include a mix of non-contact and light intermittent contact soccer activities.

Divisions will be as follows:

4 Year Olds (as of 9/26/20)	8:30am-9:15am
Kindergarten	8:30am-9:15am
1 st Grade	9:30am-10:15am
2 nd Grade	10:30am-11:15am
3 rd Grade	10:30am-11:15am

Registrations will open on Monday, September 14th. **The fee for this season is \$25/child.** Each division is limited to 32 participants. You can register on-line by going to our website: www.kitterycommunitycenter.org.

We will need volunteers to help "facilitate" the stations on Saturdays. Challenger will be hosting a coach's clinic on Sunday, September 20th to guide volunteers through the format and hand out physical copies of the curriculum. In addition, Challenger will send out weekly plans on Thursdays to the volunteers. Four volunteers would be needed in each division. Those who volunteer to facilitate the skills sessions will have their child's registration fee waived. All approved volunteers will be required to attend the coach's clinic on September 20th.
