Some good news for people seeking more options to get out of the house safely. You and your family can enjoy socially distanced meals at restaurants throughout the Village of Spring Grove, following an Ordinance signed by President Mark Eisenberg and unanimously approved by the Village Board to provide outdoor seating and expand liquor licenses.

How it works: The Village has designated the property located at the southwest corner of Main Street and Blivin Street to be used by families who are looking for public space, while social distancing from others, to sit down and enjoy their takeout food and beverages purchased via curbside pickup from restaurants within the Village of Spring Grove only. Picnic tables have been spaced off according to social distance guidelines on this beautiful green space located in the middle of the downtown area. We ask the public not to move these tables and to follow the social distancing guidelines given by our Governor.

Here are some FAQs that outline the rules for the outdoor seating area:

- Can a restaurant deliver food or liquor to our picnic table? No, you must use takeout and bring your food and packaged alcoholic beverages to this area.
- Can alcoholic beverages be consumed in these designated areas? Yes, we are allowing consumption of alcohol until the area closes at 8:30 pm.
- Can I bring my own food and/or alcoholic beverages? No, this area is for patrons of the restaurants located within the Village of Spring Grove only.
- Can I sit there all day? No, you are limited to a maximum of 90 minutes to enjoy your food and beverages.
- Can my friends and I get a table together? No, we ask that these tables are used by families only in order to follow the guidelines given by our Governor.
- If the area become a beer garden or party spot we will remove them. We do not want to do this. So please abide by our rules.
