Airport Information

FLORENCE

Florence has a regional airport serviced by American Airlines only through Charlotte, NC. There are three flights daily. The airport is approximately 3 miles from the Florence Center and Hilton Garden Inn, host hotel.

MYRTLE BEACH

Another option is the Myrtle Beach Airportserviced by Allegiant, American, Delta, Southwest, United, Frontier, and Spirit. Myrtle Beach is located 70 miles from Florence. At publication of registration material there are no plans to provide an airport shuttle from Myrtle Beach.

Regional Meeting Market Place
