For every 100 bachelor's degree awarded to women, 72 are awarded to men...In the space of just a few decades, girls and women have not just caught up with boys and men in the classroom – they have blown right past them.... (Of Boys and Men, by Richard Reeves, 2024)

Should boys be "red-shirted" (held back for Kindergarten) due to their "slower" maturation. How about the intervening years between K and College? What is the impact when men reach college?
