AUDIENCE:

This conference is designed to be of interest to a wide range of rural health professionals and advocates including: community leaders, administrators, board members, public health officials, physicians, advanced practice providers, nurses, social workers, and students from hospitals, rural health clinics, federally qualified health centers, local health departments, community mental health agencies, universities, and others interested in the development of healthcare in their community.

CRITERIA:

Proposals are welcomed for 50 minute presentations that are interactive, creative, dynamic, feature best practices in rural health, and will encompass this year's theme: *Stronger Together: Navigating a New Normal*. Presentation timeframe will include introductions, presentation material and questions and answers. Attendees should leave with specific knowledge and skills about various aspects of the topic and how it relates to their job and future development. Presentations should provide educational value and refrain from promoting a specific business, product, or service.

AREAS OF FOCUS:

The Michigan Rural Health Conference typically hosts presentations that are focused in the areas of: Health Information and Technology, Population Health, Health Equity, EMS, Workforce, Finance, Operations, Leadership and Quality Improvement. However, if you have an industry topic that is relevant but outside of these focus areas, we do encourage you to submit your proposal for consideration.

- All applicants will be notified of acceptance, regret, or wait-list by **February 4, 2022**. All applicants are encouraged to include a photograph and bio at the time proposals are submitted.
- Bios are limited to a maximum of 100 words. The goal of the presenter bio is to provide us with a high-level view of your career and major accomplishments.
