IMPORTANT! RVEF UPDATED COVID-19 GUIDELINES AND REIMBURSMENT POLICY

NEW! In response to safety concerns we will be limiting each after school class to students only at the class assigned location. For instance, classes at Sequoia after school will ONLY be open to Sequoia students.

THESE GUIDELINES ARE BASED ON RVUSD GUIDELINES:

MASKS

QUARANTINE

If your student tests positive for COVID they will be required to follow the district guidelines for quarantine. If your student's class is placed on Modified Quarantine the district will NOT allow your student to attend any extra-curricular activities (i.e. RVEF in-person classes).

NEW! REFUND POLICY

Registration fees will not be reduced or pro-rated due to illness, COVID related or not. When you enroll your child(ren), you are reserving the time, space, staffing, and program materials for your child whether they attend or not.

All other aspects of our refund policy remain the same:

If RVEF cancels a class due to low enrollment, you will receive a full refund. A non-refundable processing fee of 5% is deducted for each class dropped 1 week prior to class start date. There will be no refunds giving the week leading up to the class start date or thereafter.
