## Details:

- We plan to fund up to 8 proposals
- You can request up to \$500
- Proposals should come from program directors and/or associate program directors. A
  faculty member could be designated as the primary sponsor of the event.
- Proposal team must include at least one resident or chief resident in good standing from each program to serve as champions;
- Must involve at least 2 different residency/fellowship programs
- Program or activity must broadly address well-being and social connection
- Submit a post-activity report

## Parameters of activities that could be funded

- Examples: picnics, athletic events, trivia nights, fitness challenges, story slams, reflection activities, community outreach/volunteer activities, speakers plus discussion, etc.
- Activities could be virtual. However, we encourage safe,\* in-person events.
- We are sure there are other ideas too be creative!

Proposals should be submitted through Qualtrics and will need to include the following information:

Program names (at least 2 programs must participate)
PD/APD/ or faculty sponsor names (one from each program)
Resident champion name(s) (one from each program)
Problem statement (why is this needed for your groups?)
Goal for the activity/program (what do you hope that this will accomplish?)
How many residents/fellows do you expect to participate?
What is the activity that you propose?
When will it take place?
Proposed budget

August 13, 2021	Funding decisions released
May 1, 2022	Last day for events

Receipts must be submitted within 2 weeks of the event for reimbursement.
