

# RECYCLE WITH Revolution

## GRAIN & SILAGE BAG RECYCLING PROGRAM

At Revolution, we want to make recycling your grain & silage bags easy and impactful. To ensure your bags can be collected by our drivers, please follow the below guidelines:

- The farm/business should remove all grain from bags and machine-roll the bag into a tight bale.
- The bags should be tied with one piece of twine.
- Once the farm or business has a minimum of 40,000 lbs. of baled grain bags in a single location, please contact Revolution's Price Murphy for pickup.
- The truck will arrive onsite and the farm or business should use a skid steer and mobile loading dock to load the 40,000 lbs. of machine rolled grain bags onto the truck.
- Loader should stack the bags tightly, floor-to-ceiling, spanning the entire length of the trailer or as much as needed to achieve 40,000 lbs. of material on the trailer. (PLEASE NO PALLETS!)
- Trucks should be loaded within 2 hours of arriving for the scheduled appointment.
- The staging lot should be 1 acre or more and either be paved or heavily graveled to ensure minor weather changes do not negatively affect truck access or the loading process.
- Staging lots should provide easy access to the interstate and be convenient for truck drivers to locate.
- Trailers used for pick up will be enclosed, 53 ft. dry van trailers.

### Non-negotiables that impact our ability to collect:

- 40,000 lbs of material is the MINIMUM acceptable load weight
- Revolution does NOT pay for loading, material, or loading equipment.
- We cover the freight method of our choosing only.
- The driver will NOT assist in loading and will not train you how to load. These are not Revolution employees.
- Revolution will NOT pick partial loads or make multiple stops to fill a trailer.
- Any failure to follow these guidelines will result in an immediate and permanent discontinuation of service.
