Abstract topics may include, but are not limited to effects of maternal conditions on the fetus, neuroimaging, non-invasive monitoring, dysmorphology, genetics and/or counseling, congenital infections, fetal interventions, placenta, fetal/neonatal outcome, ethics and fetal program development/quality improvement.
